Frequently Asked Mulch Blower Questions

1) What is the cost of blower installation?

All jobs are priced by the cubic yard installed. We have a 7 yard minimum for installation jobs and the price will include material, installation, labor and minimal clean-up (we will use our blowers and brooms to clean any over spray the best we can before we leave. However, if the building or sidewalk is wet from rain or sprinklers, you may choose to wash some of these areas with a hose after we leave).

2) Do you deliver to homes as well as large commercial businesses?

Yes, most homes require more than our 7 yard minimum.

3) How do I determine how much mulch I will need?

The easiest way to figure how much mulch your property will need is to measure the square footage of the area you want to cover and then use our Mulch Calculator to figure the amount of mulch required. It is recommended that you put down 2 inches initially and add to that periodically as it breaks down.

4) How far will your hose reach?

Our truck carries 200 feet of hose. If more is needed, let us know prior to installation.

5) What products can you blow?

We can apply soils, mulches and composts very effectively.

6) Why blow it instead of manual application?

- We achieve a more uniform and even application with very little waste
- There are no unsightly piles to deal with
- It is fast and efficient, which saves you time and money
- Accessibility to remote areas with no damaging tire tracks in the yard

7) Will blowing the mulch in hurt my plants?

No, our trained installers are extremely careful not to blow directly onto the more delicate plants. We would prefer that your annuals be planted two weeks prior to installation, but will be accommodating regardless.

8) Do I need to rake the bark when you are finished?

No, our finished job is much better than you could ever expect with a rake. We even blow under shrubs and trees that you would not consider doing by hand.

9) How thick can the product be blown?

We can apply mulch from 1/4" to 5" thick or more, depending on the job needs.

10) Do I have to be home when the job is done?

No, you do not need to be home. We will get your instructions over the phone or you can leave notes or indicators where you do and do not want the mulch installed. The average job is completed in about 1 ½ hours and payment will be arranged in advance. We do, however, ask that you complete the following checklist before our arrival:

- Please refrain from watering for 24 hours prior to our arrival
- Please turn off all automatic sprinkler systems
- Please close all doors and windows
- Please cover water features and other areas that may be sensitive to contamination by mulch dust
- Please confine pets
- Please have beds prepared to be mulched (i.e. weeds and debris removed, pre-emergent applied, and landscape fabric installed if desired)
